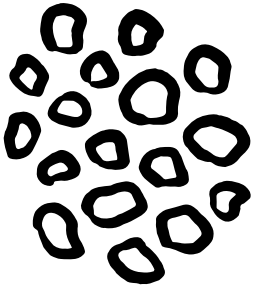

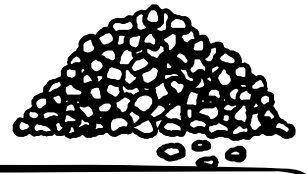
Coast of Maine SOIL SUPERHEROS!

KELP MEAL



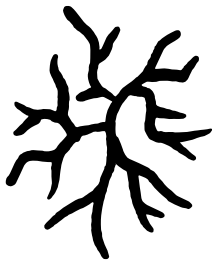

COCONUT COIR

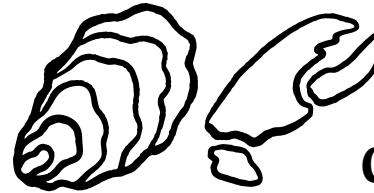


Coconut coir is like a cozy blanket for plant roots. It helps the soil hold onto water, making sure plants stay hydrated and happy.

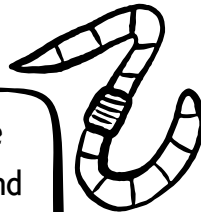
COMPOST
